NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

**PROPOSED SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT TO THE CITY'S 2008 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN**

On February 17, 2009, the U.S. Congress passed the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 ("ARRA" or "Recovery Act"). Subsequently, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD") announced the availability of \$275,195 in Community Development Block Grant-Recovery ("CDBG-R") funding available to the City of Rancho Cucamonga. CDBG-R funding is to be used to stimulate the economy through measures that modernize the Nation's infrastructure, improve energy efficiency, and expand educational opportunities and access to health care. The draft CDBG-R Substantial Amendment addresses the City's proposed allocation and use of these funds.

**PUBLIC HEARING** – All interested persons are invited to attend a public hearing on Wednesday, June 3, 2009, at 7:00 p.m. in the City Council Chamber at 10500 Civic Center Drive, Rancho Cucamonga, CA. The City Council will hold this public hearing in order to obtain citizen input on the draft CDBG-R Substantial Amendment to the 2008 Annual Action Plan.

**PROPOSED FUNDING** – The City expects to receive \$275,195 in CDBG-R funds.

**PROPOSED PROJECTS** – The allocation of CDBG-R funds will include:

• Calle Vejar Street Improvements	\$247,685
• CDBG-R Administration	<u>\$27,510</u>
<b>Total CDBG-R Funds</b>	<b>\$275,195</b>

**PUBLIC AVAILABILITY** – The draft CDBG-R Substantial Amendment to the 2008 Annual Action Plan will be available on the City's website at <http://www.cityofrc.us/> under the Planning Department link on Tuesday, May 26, 2009, a minimum of 7 days prior to the public hearing. The final CDBG-R Substantial Amendment is due to HUD on Friday, June 5, 2009.
