### REQUIREMENTS OF THE ENERGY EFFICIENCY REIMBURSEMENT PROGRAM (EERP):

The Building and Safety Department has received a grant from the Department of Energy and will be offering a one time reimbursement up to the cost of the qualified project, but not to exceed \$500 per homeowner or address to Rancho Cucamonga residents for the purchase and installation of qualified Energy Efficient appliances in the same location. Requests will be accepted on a first come first serve basis until funding has been expended.

To qualify for the EERP program, you must be a Rancho Cucamonga resident and show proof of purchase and installation of qualified Energy Efficient Appliance(s). Purchases can not be prior to October 1, 2009.

To apply for a reimbursement, appliances must meet the criteria as described below and a permit must be on record with the department.

### QUALIFIED PERMITTED APPLIANCES (check all that apply):

- Forced Air Unit (FAU/AC)
- Fluorescent Lighting with new electrical wiring
- Air Supply Ducting
- Solar Photovoltaic System
- Water Heater- Conventional or Tankless
- Dishwasher with new water line and electrical outlet
- Garbage Disposal with new electrical wiring
- Built-in Microwaves with new electrical wiring
- Ovens/Cook Tops with new electrical wiring or gas line
- New installation Ceiling fans with new electrical wiring

## **ENERGY EFFICIENCY APPLIANCE REQUEST FOR REIMBURSEMENT FORM**

The Building and Safety Department will be offering a one time reimbursement to home owners who elect to purchase, replace and install qualified energy efficient appliances. This program will only be offered as long as funding is available, and requests will be processed on a first come, first serve basis. The qualifying period for items purchased can not be prior to October 1, 2009. Please allow thirty (30) days for your reimbursement to be received.

To submit for a reimbursement, please make sure to follow the directions below. We can not be responsible for any information that is omitted, and any missing information can cause a delay or denial of your reimbursement request.

### **PROCESS FOR REIMBURSEMENT REQUEST:**

1. Purchase qualified energy efficient appliance
2. Pull permit from Building and Safety Department
3. Request a EERP form and an inspection time (or call later to schedule the inspection)
4. Inspector will initial the EERP form verifying inspection and final approval
5. Homeowner submits this form along with the following:
  - a. Proof of purchase (a copy of your receipt or contract)
  - b. Validation sticker to be Energy Efficient (sticker attached to the appliance)

To request an inspection, contact the Building and Safety Department at (909) 477-2710 and ask for an Energy Efficiency Inspection.
